Kindness

TEXT: Galatians 5:22

Things to consider from God's word while pursuing a life of kindness.

1. God wants us to love kindness

- a. Micah 6:8
 - i. If you want to love kindness:
 - 1. Show it
 - 2. Receive it

2. Kindness is proactive.

- a. Zechariah 7:8-10
- b. James 1:27
 - i. A special group of people to show kindness to.
 - 1. Exodus 22:22-24

3. Bond with kindness

- a. Proverbs 3:3

4. A life of kindness is a fulfilled life

- a. Proverbs 21:21
- b. Proverbs 19:22
 - i. Kindness wins friends

5. Kind words should come easy.

- a. Proverbs 31:26
- b. Before you speak ask yourself:
 - i. Is it true
 - ii. Is it necessary
 - iii. Is it edifying
 - iv. Is it Christlike
- c. Your words reveal your heart
- d. Matthew 12:34
- e. **A man once said, "To speak kindly does not hurt the tongue".**

6. Jesus Yoke is easy.

- a. Matthew 11:28-30
 - i. What make his yoke kind:
 - ii. He is meek and humble
 - iii. He teaches
 - iv. He provides rest
 - v. His yoke is light

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- b. I John 5:3
 - i. His yoke is not heavy.
- 7. Kindness needs to reach the unthankful and evil**
 - a. Luke 6:35
 - i. Holy Spirit kindness is not selfish kindness
 - ii. Kindness says, "I ought to do that".
- 8. The wrong friends can ruin your kindness**
 - a. I Corinthians 15:33
- 9. The Lord's kindness should motivate us to grow**
 - a. I Peter 2:1-3
 - i. Has the kindness of God impacted you?
